The Purpose of Prayer, Cause Me Prayers and All our Problems

- I. Introduction
 - i. This is a review of :
 - 1. John 14.13: And I will do whatever you ask in my name so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.
 - 2. John 16:24 ... Ask and you will receive and your joy will be complete.
 - 3. Prayer is not about asking for a safe, soft, comfortable, happy life.
- II. Body
 - a. Purpose of Prayer
 - i. To give God glory- Jesus wants to answer our prayers to bring glory to His father.
 - 1. Prayer is not about asking for whatever you want so that you can have a safe, soft, comfortable, happy life.
 - 2. Prayer and life is about glorifying the Father.
 - 3. What is our motivation for prayer? God says no to prayers for selfish pleasures.
 - ii. Prayer is about your joy being made full. It is about joy in glorifying God.
 - iii. Glorifying God and having joy in the fullest are not separate. They are to be the same.
 - iv. Prayer is not about getting whatever we want and tacking on "in the name of Jesus."
 - b. Doing things in our own strength
 - i. John 15.5- Jesus says apart from me you can do nothing.
 - ii. I Cor. 3.15- The works we do in our own power will burn up.
 - iii. Ps. 127.1- You labor in vain if you try to live the Christian life in your own power and strength.
 - iv. Ezek. 36.26-27- God says I will put my spirit within you and cause you to walk in my statutes.

- c. God wants to do the work in us.
 - i. The true work that needs to be done in our lives is a spiritual matter, by the Holy Spirit inside us. We can do nothing on our own that can bring about any change to us spiritually.
 - 1. Romans 8.7-8 Those in the flesh cannot please God.
 - ii. If we do the work ourselves, we will get the glory for it. We need cause me prayers.
- d. Cause me prayers
 - i. Cause me prayers realize that, "I can do certain things in my own strength but they are not going to produce anything worth while.
 - ii. Cause me prayers communicate to God that you want to be 100% dependent upon God to work in and through you so that He gets the glory.
 - iii. Our spiritual growth is totally, 100% dependent upon God. We can do nothing. Our responsibility is to give God times and opportunities to work.
- e. Come to God with All your problems
 - i. Matt. 11:28 God says come to me all who are weary and heavy-laden and I will give you rest.
 - ii. Ps. 50.15- We are told to call upon God in the day of trouble.
 - iii. The best way you can honor God and glorify God is to bring him all your problems.
- III. Conclusion:
 - a. Prayer is about two key components:
 - i. First, Glorify God
 - 1. by what you pray for
 - 2. by your dependence upon Him
 - 3. By coming to Him with all your problems
 - ii. Having your joy be full as you see the answers to your prayers.
